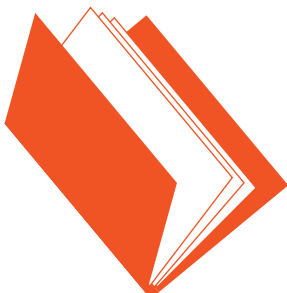


Champagne Reception Monday 29 September 17:30 - 19:00 Bridge Club Level 1
