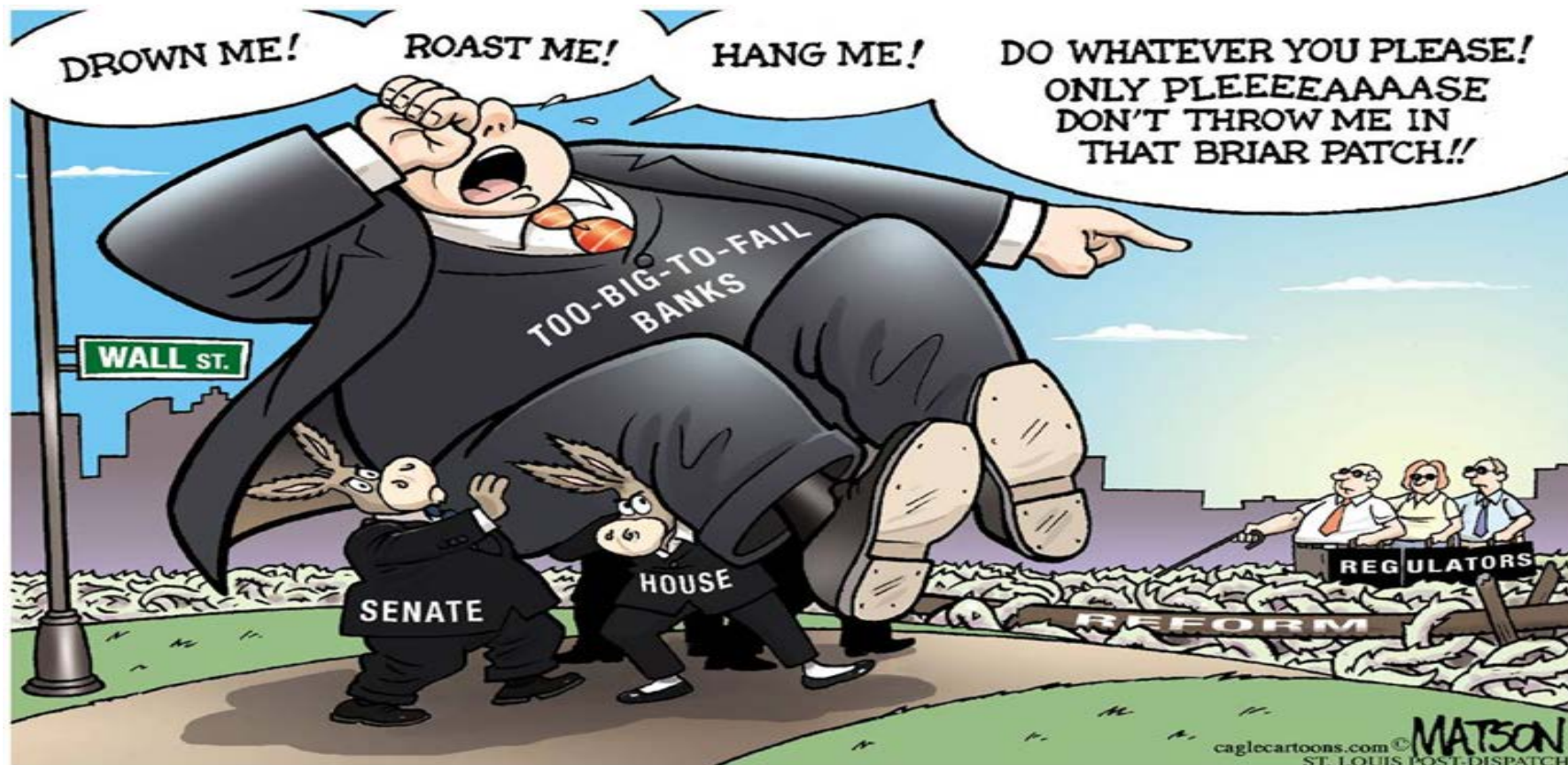

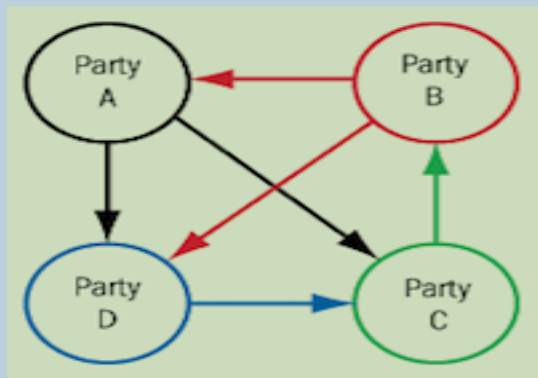

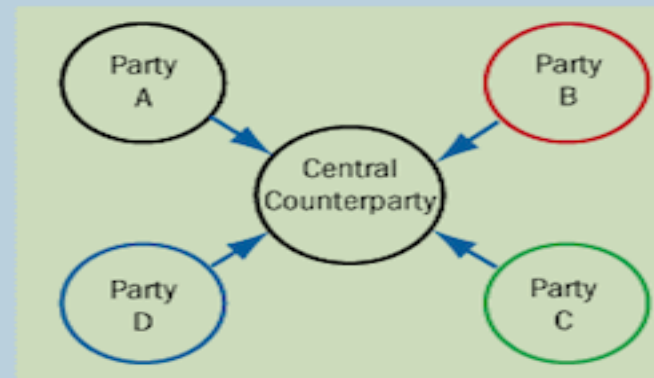
How trading worlds differ
