Programme Overview

The SWIFT Institute, set up by SWIFT, funds independent research, supports knowledge-led debate and provides a forum where academics and financial practitioners can learn from each other. The primary focus of the SWIFT Institute's work is transaction banking, covering the areas of payments & banking, securities, cyber security, technology & innovation, regulation & compliance and leadership. To date more than 40 research grants have been issued and ten conferences held. All of the Institute's research is freely available to download and share at www.swiftinstitute.org.

Core Objectives

Extend understanding of current practice and future needs in global financial services, with a particular focus on transaction banking.

Foster independent research by issuing grants and freely sharing the results across the globe.

Act as a catalyst for bringing the SWIFT community and academics together to explore ideas, share knowledge and extend mutual understanding.

The SWIFT Institute returns to Sibos bringing some of the keenest thought leaders from academia (and industry) to share insights and the latest research on topics impacting the global financial industry. Research grant recipients will present their insights on: DLT / blockchain, shadow payments, gender diversity, banking platforms, instant payments and cyber. Experts will also discuss artificial intelligence, geopolitics, the disruptive future and how to stay ahead of it, financial market infrastructures and data science.

We will host our fourth annual Student Challenge. Five university teams will present their ideas on how to use artificial intelligence to improve fraud detection and prevention in an increasingly instant payment world.

Finally, on Talent Thursday we will host some of the finalists of the global bi-annual Ethics & Trust in Finance Prize competition. Tomorrow's leaders will share their visions of the future.
